You're what Humankindness is all about. The Humankindness Gala was created to unleash the power of humanity on major health and social issues facing our communities. The evening supports our most vulnerable neighbors to embrace hope by funding important health equity initiatives at CommonSpirit.

Your support will ensure that, together, we advance health equity through our national initiatives like the following:

Violence Prevention

Violence undermines physical and mental health and is often driven by social and economic inequities. CommonSpirit is proud of its system-wide program to identify and assist victims of human trafficking, abuse, neglect, and violence.

Your support helps us train thousands of physicians and caregivers to understand the signs and identify the thousands of patients and families impacted by human trafficking. Donor funding also launched the Gun Safety and Education Initiative that has already provided more than 1,000 gun locks to families and educated almost 9,000 students on gun safety.

Behavioral Health

Behavioral health is a national epidemic affecting one in five adults. Those living below the poverty level are twice as likely to be impacted. CommonSpirit's emergency departments are often the first refuge for people in mental health crises.

Your support helps CommonSpirit expand programs that address the stigma around mental health challenges; more quickly screen patients; and provide better opportunities for patients to see mental health professionals. It doesn't happen without your donor funds which launched telehealth services that enable pediatric doctors to speak in real-time to psychiatrists when a maternal mental health issue occurs.

Healthier Communities

Caring for the whole person goes beyond the walls of the hospital. CommonSpirit is committed to offering programs that address the factors that contribute to poor health such as the lack of good housing, healthy food, safe transportation, and resources for aging patients. We've created Community Care Networks that help people navigate the complex health care system and access available resources inside and outside the hospital.

Your support has funded pathways for families to access healthy food, find shelter and transportation, and has provided resources so families don't have to choose between seeing their doctor and paying their rent.

More in Common Alliance

Donor funding continues to lift up our historic partnership between Morehouse School of Medicine and CommonSpirit Health to address the lack of representation among care providers.

Your support helps us to expand undergraduate and graduate medical education programs that train the next generation of culturally competent health clinicians and researchers.
